## Westlake Teen to Hold Fund Raiser for her foundation!



The daughter of a prominent REALTOR® has been inspired to help those less fortunate. Gabriella Brignardello is a sophomore at La Reina High School in Thousand Oaks and she has started her own foundation, Mi Casa de Angeles. During trips to visit her father's homeland, she decided to help children in Peru who were not as fortunate as she. "It is heartbreaking to see so many children so poor, This heartbreaking to see so many children so poor, begging for money," Gabriella says, "My main focus is getting teens in this country involved in service projects like this. My goal is to raise awareness." She has raised around \$1,500 towards her goal of building a school for 150 to 200 children in Lima, Peru. On Saturday, February 6, she is holding a garage sale and hopes to raise a couple thousand more. She figures she will need a half a million dollars to build the school, and \$200,000 to run it every year. That's a lofty goal for a teenager, but Gabriella has always enjoyed raising money.

The idea began to crystallize when she thought about the fact that she has been fortunate to be able to receive a good quality education, something that the children of the mostly illiterate country of Peru would never have. With 45% of the population living below the poverty level, she decided that education could "give them a chance to succeed."

Her next goal is to gamer some larger corporate sponsors, primarily those already doing business in Peru. She is currently working with some architects and others in Peru to design the school and come up with some more definite costs.
